PLSO Daily Updates (11/13/24)



Protesters block the road on the N1 in Ressano Garcia, causing major traffic back ups and eventually forcing the border authorities to close Ressano-Lebombo Border Crossing for the second time in one week.

Day One of the “Fourth Phase” of Venancio Mondlane’s Election Protest Ends with Multiple Deaths and Nationwide Protests.

Mozambique experienced widespread demonstrations, with protest groups focusing on shutting down major ports and border posts. Significant incidents were reported the provinces of Nampula and Quelimane. In Nampula’s Carrupeia and Namicopo neighborhoods, police used live ammunition, resulting in casualties. Pemba’s demonstrations remained largely peaceful. In Quelimane, opposition politician Manuel de Araújo and his wife were affected by tear gas. The protests reflect growing public frustration with the police reactions, and several incidents of violence were directed at the police.

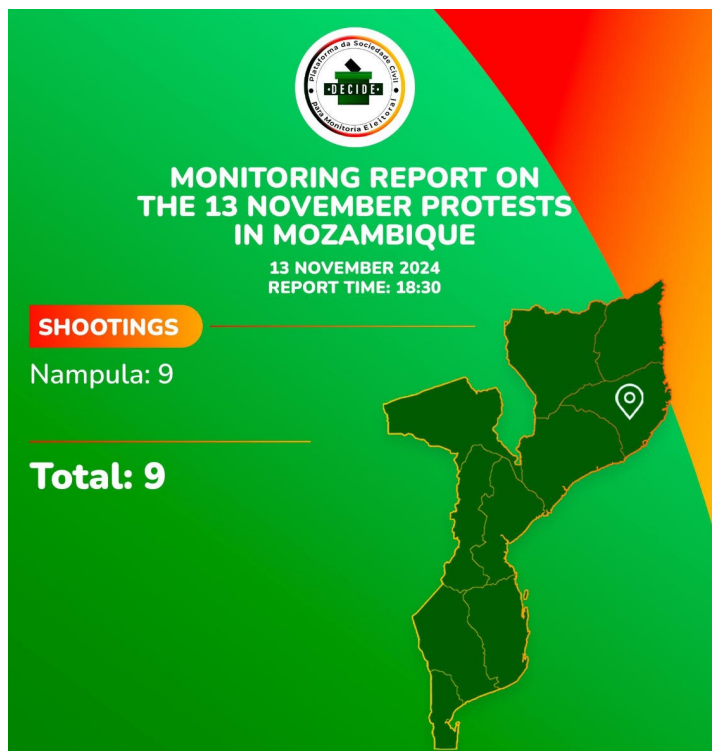
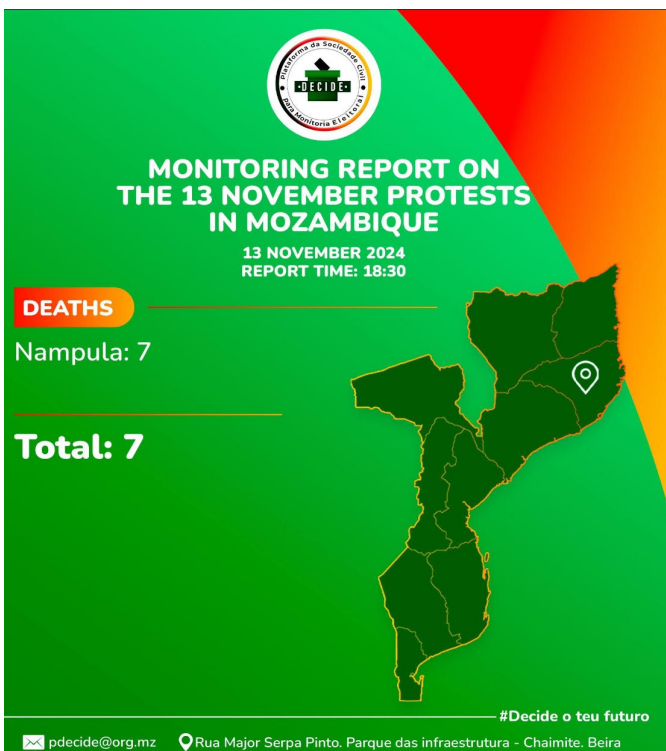

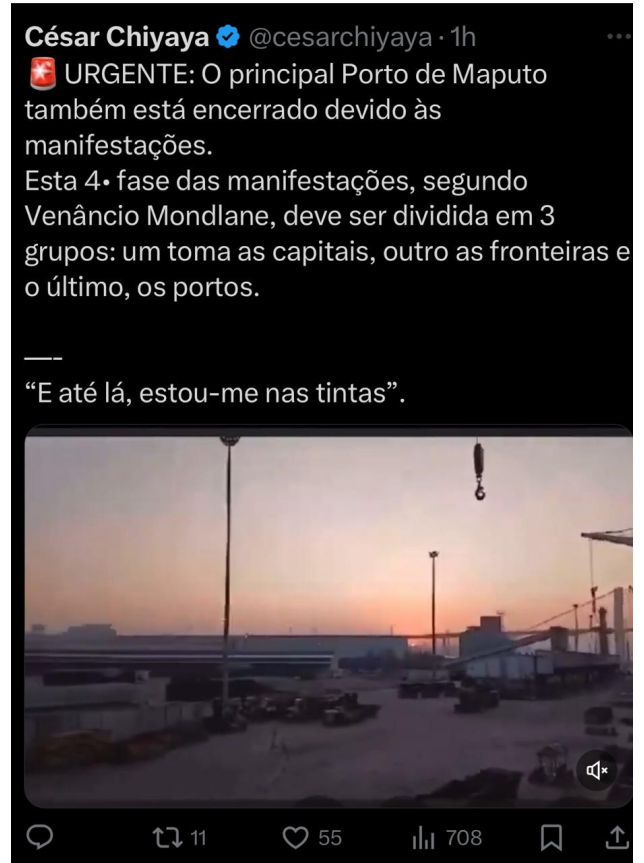

- **Maputo Province:** Increased movement in the city, with notable police presence; Matola City reports demonstrations; temporary halt at KM4 near Ressano Garcia Border.
- **Nampula Province:** Roadblock in Namicopo with two fatalities, two injuries; police dispersed demonstration in Carrupeia; reduced port activity in Nacala.
- **Manica Province:** Overturned truck blocks EN6 road ([Jornal Noticias report](#)).
- **Cabo Delgado Province:** Insurgent sightings in Litapata and 24 de Marco villages; attack with one fatality in Muangaza Village, leading to displacement.

- **20:00:** Violence by Islamic State-backed insurgents triggered the displacement of 4,095 people between 23 October and 8 November in the districts of Mueda, Muidumbe, Mocímboa da Praia and Nangade in Cabo Delgado province, according to the International Organisation for Migration. In Nangade, 2,053 people fled their homes amid fears of an imminent insurgent attack on the village of Litingina between 5 and 7 November, which was reported at the time by Zitamar News.

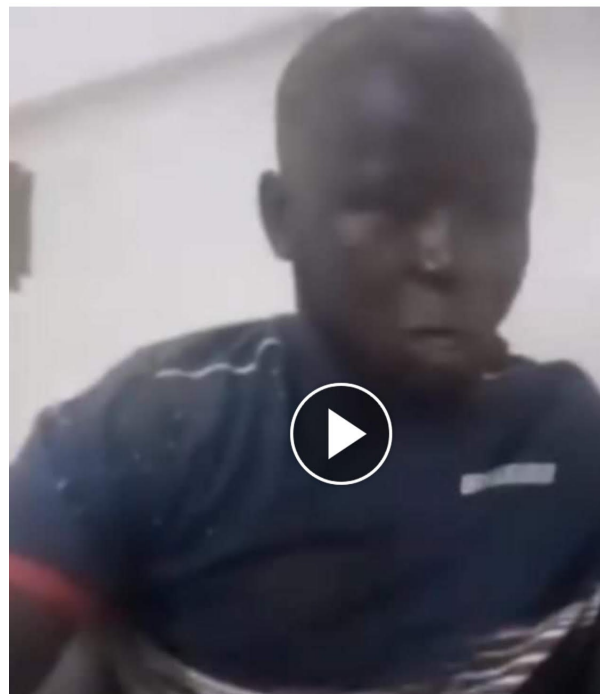

Nov 13 - The National Defense Council condemns the presence of children in demonstrations, vandalism, and the attempted subversion of the democratic order. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - Eleven people died in shipwrecks in the last two months in the province of Zambézia. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - Movement of people and goods continues normally on the Machipanda border between Mozambique and Zimbabwe. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - At least three people were fatally shot during police operations yesterday afternoon in the Namicopo neighborhood, in Nampula. [Link](#)

- **Nov 13** - Police used tear gas to disperse protesters holding a peaceful demonstration near the statue of Eduardo Mondlane in the Alto Mae neighborhood. **Aldebaran Reports**

- Nov 12 - In Nangade District, insurgents launched an attack on Muangaza, near Litingina, resulting in the beheading of at least one individual.

- Nov 12 - A group of insurgents was reportedly spotted in Litapata on November 12, and there are signs of insurgent activity in the 24 de Marco villages in Muidumbe district.

Nov 12 - The town of Macomia, in Cabo Delgado, saw an unusual movement by the Armed Forces between Monday and Tuesday, generating concern among residents. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - Maputo International Airport reinforces measures to prevent and combat organized and transnational crime. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - The National Criminal Investigation Service (SERNIC) rescued two businessmen on the same day and in the same captivity: a Mozambican businessman kidnapped on August 5 and a Portuguese businessman kidnapped on October 29. [Link](#)

Nov 13 - Mozambique's Armed Forces spent more than 80% of their budget in nine months. [Link](#)
